Northland Telephone Company of Maine, Inc. d/b/a FairPoint Communications ("FairPoint") is filing for effect December 1, 2013 tariff changes consisting of:

This filing grandfathers FairPoint's Voice Advantage Bundles in NH PUC No. 1, Section 9 Pages 8 through 10. FairPoint proposes to grandfather its Voice Advantage Bundles for existing customers and allow them to keep their existing services. FairPoint proposes to no longer offer new customers the Voice Advantage Bundles service options. Existing customers are being notified in their November 2013 bills.

On July 17, 2013, FairPoint introduced for effect August 16, 2013, a new residential bundles service option called Voice Advantage II. These bundles provide residential customers with the option of subscribing to service packages that provide a dial tone access line, local usage, IntraLATA toll usage and InterLATA toll usage for a single bundled rate. The grandfathering of Voice Advantage Bundles will have no impact on FairPoint's customers, as Voice Advantage II provides similar bundle calling options.
