Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with the Commission's Order No. 25,654, enclosed is an original copy of the monthly calculation of the projected (over)/under collection for the Summer 2014 period.

The computations are based on actual costs and revenues through July and forecasts for the remainder of the period. The calculations show a projected over-collection through October 31, 2014 of \$16,387 and would necessitate a \$0.1771 decrease to the current Cost of Gas Rate of \$1.5181, resulting in a revised COG Rate of \$1.3410 per therm. At this time, the Company elects to implement the revised rate of \$1.3410 per therm for the September 1st billing cycle.

Included in this package is an original copy of New Hampshire Gas Corporation's tariff page in compliance with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission's Order No. 25,654 – Order Approving Cost of Gas Rate, issued April 25, 2014.
