On March 17, 2014, Liberty Utilities, EnergyNorth Natural Gas Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities (Liberty), filed with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) its proposed cost of gas (COG) rates for the summer period, May 1, 2014 through October 31, 2014, included in the filing were revised tariff pages and supporting materials for the changed rates. The petition and subsequent docket filings, other than any information on which confidential treatment is requested or granted by the Commission, will be posted by the Commission's website at <http://www.puc.nh.gov/RegulatoryDocket/2014/14-076.html>.

The proposed residential COG rate is \$0.0000 per therm, a 90 percent decrease from the current rate of \$0.0000 per therm for the summer. The proposed change to the residential COG rate, compared with previously approved changes in distribution rates, and the Local Distribution Adjustment Charge, is expected to decrease a typical residential heating customer's summer bill by approximately \$19 or 7.9 percent compared to last summer.

The proposed commercial/industrial heating COG rate is \$0.5377 per therm and the proposed commercial/industrial high volume use COG rate is \$0.5456 per therm. The changes in commercial, industrial low and high volume use rates are commensurate with the changes in the residential COG rate, resulting in a heating rate freeze.

The filing raises *inter alia* issues related to RSA 378 on the issues and consequences of rates, rates, and changes to the reasonableness of rates to credits, supplier prices, and transportation prices, the calculation of prior period costs, and revenues, the causes and treatment of a price cap, and the causes and treatment of a price cap. Liberty reserves the right to have its petitioners represent the interests of the party's own expertise.

Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby ORDERED, that a hearing be held before the Commission on or before April 16, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. in Room 10, Concord, New Hampshire, on April 16, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

FURTHER ORDERED, that Liberty Utilities, the Staff of the Commission and any interveners hold a Technical Session on April 10, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. to review the petition and allow Liberty Utilities to provide any amendments or updates to its filing, and it is

Rules Part 203.02, Liberty Utilities shall notify all persons desiring to be heard at this hearing by publishing a copy of this Order of Notice no later than March 27, 2014 in a newspaper of general circulation in those portions of the state in which operations are conducted, publication to be documented by affidavit filed with the Commission on or before April 11, 2014, and it is
