**RE: DG 14-076 EnergyNorth Natural Gas, Inc.
 2014 Summer Period Cost of Gas – June and July 2014 Triggers**

Dear Ms. Howland:

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. (the "Company") and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") Order No. 25,658 dated April 30, 2014, in Docket DG 14-076, I enclose an original of the Company's current (July) calculation of its projected over or under collection of gas costs for the 2014 summer season ending October 31, 2014.

For the July trigger, the calculation reflects the actual May and June 2014 NYMEX settled prices. For July through October 2014, the calculation reflects the NYMEX closing prices as of June 23, 2014. The resulting projected over collection of approximately \$163,033 is approximately 1.4% of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2014 summer season.

The current and revised cost of gas rates are summarized in the following table.

Also included with this letter is an original of the trigger report for June 2014 which was not previously filed. That report resulted in a projected over collection of approximately \$133,650 is approximately 1.14% of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2014 summer season.

In accordance with Order No. 24,223 issued on October 24, 2003, the June and July trigger filings will be submitted electronically through the Commission's electronic filing system on June 25, 2014.
