Determination Regarding PSNH's Generation Assets


Petition for Intervention

The NH Sustainable Energy Association, d.b.a. NH CleanTech Council (NHCTC), submits this Petition for Intervention in the above referenced docket, and states the following:

1. NHSEA is a statewide nonprofit organization, which educates and advocates for sustainable energy in New Hampshire. We have residential and business members across the state of NH. Our business members form the advocacy arm of NHSEA, the NH CleanTech Council, whose purpose is to educate and advocate for New Hampshire's clean energy economy: to promote more innovative and clean energy policies, to attract investment, and to provide opportunity for growth.
2. NHSEA/NHCTC has an interest in the fate of PSNH's generation portfolio, both renewable-resource and fossil-fuel-based.
