On August 10, on behalf of Energy Express, Inc. we filed a petition to intervene and on August 14 we filed an opposition to the proposed Settlement Agreement. We understand that the Commission has not yet acted on our petition to intervene or on the Settlement Agreement. We await further instruction from the Commission regarding the next phase of this case.

We are filing this letter to call the Commission's attention to a recent Order from the Maine Public Utilities Commission directing Northern Utilities to distribute the Maine portion of the PNGTS refund directly to gas marketers that were impacted by the higher PNGTS rate. Enclosed is a copy of this Order should the Commission find it useful in deciding how to distribute the PNGTS refund to New Hampshire ratepayers.
