I, Henry Herndon, respectfully petition the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (NH PUC) for late intervention in NH PUC DE 15-137 – Gas and Electric Utilities Energy Efficiency Resource Standard (EERS).

- This petition is submitted in writing to the presiding officer, with copies [electronically] mailed to all parties named in the presiding officer's notice of hearing.
- The following stated facts demonstrate I have substantial interests that may be affected by the proceeding:
 - As a New Hampshire resident I have a personal interest in the outcome of DE 15-137.
 - As a Master's student at the University of New Hampshire completing research in the formation of New Hampshire's EERS and the NH PUC policy-making process I have substantial interests that may be affected by the proceeding.
 - My particular interest is to act as a comprehensive observer of the proceedings and filings so that they may inform my research.
- I volunteer the following conditions be imposed on my status as intervener to ensure the interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings are not impaired by my status as intervener:

- i. Will not submit requests for discovery.
- ii. Will not call witnesses.
- iii. Will not submit testimony.
- iv. Will not submit evidence.
- v. Will not submit argument.
- vi. Will not examine or cross-examine parties.
- vii. Will not participate except to the extent of being a fully noticed observer with full rights and access to information and hearings and proceedings.
