License by Notification of Existing Crossings on Existing Poles near Glen Road in the City of Lebanon.

Dear Ms. Howland,

By petition received by the Commission on May 14, 2015, in the above-captioned matter, Sovernet Fiber Corp. requested a license to place conduit, fiber optic cable and associated wires and fixtures ("Facilities") over and across the inactive rail corridor owned by the State of New Hampshire near Glen Road in the City of Lebanon, New Hampshire.

Commission staff informally contacted me to request submission of pole numbers and copies of pole attachment licenses or applications related to the crossing.

The numbers of two utility poles are as follows:

| South Side | 37 | 68/1 |

The electric utility, National Grid / Liberty, has not yet issued a license. Copies of the license issued by FairPoint, and the license application to National Grid, are enclosed. Information concerning poles not located on State lands has been redacted consistent with staff's guidance.
