On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp., d/b/a Liberty, I write to file the annual report required in the above docket.

The Settlement Agreement in the above docket provided that Liberty would file certain information related to its expansion into the Town of Pelham, as follows:

- i. A comparison of the original and updated DCF analyses;
- ii. A comparison of the original annual projected residential and C&I customer conversions and gross profit margins, by fuel type, with the actual annual conversions and gross profit margin; and
- iii. A Current Heating Fuel Value table comparing the annual average residential heating rate calculated using the Liberty bill impact schedule in its winter cost of gas filing and the cost of alternative fuels in effect at that time as reported by the New Hampshire Office of Energy and Planning
