Executive Director Howland,

On November 11, 2015, Clearview Electric, Inc. d/b/a Clearview Energy ("Clearview") submitted its initial CEPS application. Subsequently, Staff asked for revisions to Clearview's standard contract. Clearview worked with Staff to amend it standard contract language to address all New Hampshire specific concerns, which was submitted to Staff on March 3, 2016. Staff accepted those proposed changes today, and a replacement sample of Clearview's contract is enclosed for the record.

Additionally, since Clearview originally completed EDI testing with the utilities in New Hampshire, Liberty Utilities (f.k.a. National Grid d/b/a Granite State) was sold. This change in ownership required all suppliers to complete EDI testing with the new utility owner. The "Completion of EDI Testing" certificate Clearview received from Liberty Utilities, replacing the EDI testing completion letter originally provided by National Grid is also enclosed.
