The Telephone Company will, upon request 24 hours in advance, provide the TC with a statement of technical parameters that the TC's equipment must meet.

Claims for libel, slander, invasion of privacy, or infringement of copyright directly or indirectly, in whole or part, caused by or resulting from the material transmitted over the Telephone Company's facilities arising from the TC's own communications or the communications of such TC's customers or end-users made through or by means of telecommunications services furnished hereunder;
3.	Claims for patent infringement copyright directly or indirectly, in whole or part, caused by or resulting from the CLEC's or its end user's acts combining or using the service or facilities furnished by the Telephone Company in connection with facilities or equipment furnished by the end user or CLEC.
