The tariff has been revised from the July 24, 2017 filed version to reflect changes pursuant to discussions with Commission Staff. These changes are as follows:

- A reference to the interim Order No. 25,972 has been reinstated.
- In section 2, Metering, the phone line requirement for large customer generators has been removed since that is already in the Company's Standards for Interconnection as well as Guideline for Interconnecting Distributed Generation.
- In section 4, Renewable Energy Certificates, the reference to "terms and conditions provided by the Company" has been removed.
