Dear Director Howland:

On June 23, 2017 in the above-captioned proceeding, the Commission issued Order No. 26,029. That order established numerous requirements for utilities and others, including that Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource") was to perform a full marginal cost-of-service study within 12 months of the date of the order. Order No. 26,029 at 61. Consistent with the Commission's directive (as modified by secretarial letter of June 29, 2018), Eversource filed its marginal cost of service study on July 16, 2018.

Subsequently, on February 20, 2019, the Commission issued Order No. 26,221 in this same docket. Among other things, that order stated "We also direct Eversource to file in this docket its updated MCOS Study, and a summary of the material changes between the original and updated versions of that study, at the same time the updated MCOS Study is filed in its rate case." On May 28, 2019, Eversource submitted its full rate case filing in Docket No. DE 19-057, including its updated marginal cost of service study. In compliance with the Commission's directive in Order No. 26,221, enclosed with this letter is Eversource's updated marginal cost of service study and a summary of the material changes from the study filed on July 16, 2018.
