To clarify, I am not serving as a "legal" representative or counsel, only a lead spokesperson, where appropriate and in the interest of administrative efficiency.

Please also note I have not relinquished my co-petitioner status. While we had some discussion of RSA 541-A:32, I (b) at the pre-hearing conference, this statute does not apply as I am <u>not</u> an intervenor, I am a co-petitioner. It is unclear whether the Secretarial Letter dated January 12, 2017 was intended to be a ruling somehow unilaterally striking my co-petitioner status. If this is the intention of the Secretarial Letter dated January 12, 2017, I respectfully request an actual ruling/order that explains this decision.
