Dear Ms. Howland:

FairPoint Communications, Inc. ("FairPoint") received your letter today suspending the date of the Technical Session next Wednesday at the request of the Hearings Examiner. FairPoint considers it unfortunate that the suspension decision was made without input from the parties affected. In FairPoint's view, the Technical Session should be reinstated.

As my letter to you earlier today indicated, FairPoint does not believe that the current state of discovery in this matter warrants any changes in the Procedural Schedule. The deadline for the Petitioners' responses to the Staff's Data Requests (Sets 1 and 2) is the close of business today. FairPoint has now delivered Supplemental Responses to Staff Set 1 and its Responses to Staff Set 2. It is premature to suspend the Technical Session based on missing discovery before the deadline for responses has even arrived.

As I explained in my earlier letter, FairPoint welcomes the opportunities afforded both by the meeting with the Hearings Examiner on Tuesday and by the Technical Session on Wednesday to work through any remaining open discovery items. This is a proper function for the Technical Session, and that opportunity will be lost if the session is postponed or canceled. The discovery process in this Docket has already seen several missed opportunities to clarify and resolve the data requests in a way that would have facilitated a more efficient result.

FairPoint would prefer taking advantage of all available opportunities from this point forward to keep the Procedural Schedule on track. Reinstating the Technical Session for this Wednesday would be an important step in this process.
