This is not the same gas product previously considered "clean and natural". The citizens of the Keene area deserve to know more and to be allowed to comment on this proposal.

The longer term economics of investing in fracked gas expansion, facilities and infrastructure is being called into question as wind, water and solar renewable energy technologies are competitive with, or about to be so, fossil fuel electricity generation. This in spite of the fact that government subsidies lean overwhelming toward fossil fuels. We need to discuss and debate where best to invest limited money and resources when all indications are that renewables will soon be the better, cheaper way to invest in out energy infrastructure.
