Dear Mr. Hayes:

On June 28, 2017, Lakes Region Planning Commission submitted an application with the Commission to register as a provider of electric aggregation service. Staff reviewed the application and determined that it is complete.

The Commission approves your application effective as of July 5, 2017. The registration is for a term of two years and expires at the end of business on July 5, 2019. Pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2003.05(a), you must submit a renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the registration approved here, on or before May 6, 2019.

Please be aware that registered providers of electric aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000 - Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at: http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC2000.pdf. Please also be aware that the Commission has opened Docket DRM 16-853 to consider revisions to these rules. All non-confidential filings in Docket DRM 16-853 can be found at http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Docketbk/2016/16-853.html. The revised rules may contain different requirements for maintaining registration as a provider of electric aggregation service that might affect your registration.

Please note that, effective as of July 1, 2014, each registered electric load aggregator is subject to an annual assessment of \$2,000, unless it demonstrates that its gross revenue in New Hampshire during the preceding fiscal year (from July 1 through June 30) was less than \$10,000, pursuant to RSA 363-A:2, III and 5.
