On September 11, 2017, Teleport Communications of America LLC (AT&T) filed a petition asking the Commission to make a full code of 10,000 telephone numbers available by overturning Neustar's original decision to withhold the code.

Staff has discussed the request with AT&T and sought additional information regarding its customer's need for the number code.

AT&T has worked with its customer to more clearly quantify the need, and has now reported to Staff that the customer can proceed with its project without obtaining a full code or even a block of numbers at this time.
