Dear Executive Director Howland:

I am writing on behalf of CS Berlin Ops, Inc. pursuant to Rule 2003.1(c) to request a waiver of said rule and kindly ask for an extension of the time period for another 60 days.

Under said rule: "The commission shall reject the application when information required to complete a CEPS registration is not provided by the applicant within 60 days of request for such information."

CS Berlin Ops, Inc. applied for its ISO membership and is still working through the ISO New England the registration process. We expect to meet the requirements for membership. Given the timing of the ISO membership meetings, we assume we will be accepted by early March 2018 and therefore expect to be compliant with the deficiency letter you sent us by March 25<sup>th</sup>.

The 60 day extension, if approved by, is appreciated as we look to actively sell locally generated power in New Hampshire.
