This follows up on my letter of December 29, 2017 in connection with the above-referenced docket.

The OCA has had an opportunity to consult with Commission Staff with respect to the requested rules waiver. Additionally, we participated earlier today in a teleconference with representatives of Staff and Liberty Utilities. Based on those conversations, the OCA agrees that the Commission should grant the requested rules waiver subject to the understanding that the waiver does not preclude a thorough review of the prudence of the company's management of on-site storage this winter.

It is the OCA's understanding that Staff will file a recommendation in the near future. The OCA concurs with Staff's recommendation, relying on its expertise with respect to gas supply management issues.
