Dear Ms. Watson:

On September 10, 2018, Atlas Commodities II Retail Energy, LLC d/b/a Atlas Retail Energy (Atlas Retail Energy) submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Staff reviewed the application and determined that it is complete.

Commission Staff filed a memorandum on September 13, 2018 recommending that Atlas Retail Energy's registration renewal application be approved for a two-year term, beginning on November 9, 2018, pursuant to Puc 2003.06(e)(1).

Your application for registration renewal is approved effective as of November 9, 2018, under Puc 2003.06(e)(1). The renewed registration is for a term of two years and expires at the close of business on November 9, 2020. Pursuant to Puc 2003.06(a), you must submit your next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the approved registration term, on or before September 10, 2020.

Please be aware that registered providers of electric aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000 – Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules. Please note that, effective as of July 1, 2014, each registered electric aggregator is subject to an annual assessment of \$2,000, unless it demonstrates that its gross revenue in New Hampshire during the preceding fiscal year (from July 1 through June 30) was less than \$10,000, pursuant to RSA 363-A:2, III and 5.
