On November 28, 2018, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. filed proposed tariff changes for effect January 1, 2019. The proposed changes modify the tariffs to remove the electricity consumption tax from rates pursuant to House Bill 517, which repealed RSA 83-E, the electricity consumption tax, effective January 1, 2019.

Staff filed a memorandum on December 12, 2018 confirming that the tariff changes comply with House Bill 517.
