Dear Secretary Howland:

On behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("UES"), enclosed please find the final results of its recovery of storm costs associated with Winter Storm Quinn, which occurred in March 2018. UES was allowed recovery of these costs over the three year period, May 2019 through April 2022.

In accordance with its tariff, UES is to file with the Commission, no later than sixty days after the conclusion of the recovery period, this final reconciliation, with the disposition of any remaining balance subject to Commission review and approval.

As part of its Annual Reconciliation and Rate filing, dated June 17, 2022, in DE 22-038, UES has proposed to include the reconciliation balance associated with its Storm Recovery Adjustment Factor ("SRAF") in its External Delivery Charge for August 1, 2022. This balance is comprised of the reconciliation associated with Winter Storm Quinn, as well as the balances from the December 2008 Ice Storm and February 2010 Wind Storm which ended recovery in April 2019, and October 2017 Wind Storm which ended recovery in April 2021. Effective May 1, 2022, the SRAF is \$0 as UES is not currently recovering any storms through this mechanism.
