## Re: Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy Docket No. DE 19-104, Clean Innovation Community Solar Pilot Proposal

- Request to withdraw petition and close docket

Director Howland:

On behalf of Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource"), this letter serves as a request to withdraw Eversource's petition on this matter and ask that the Commission close the docket. Eversource is committed to launching a meaningful Low-Moderate Income ("LMI") community solar pilot program that would deliver the kinds of benefits outlined in Eversource's initial filing in this proceeding. However, at this time and in light of changed circumstances since the time of filing, Eversource believes it is necessary to explore additional options around the program, particularly ones those that would reduce program costs. Rather than attempt to update what has already been provided at an asyet-undetermined future date, Eversource has determined it would be more efficient to withdraw the pending proposal while it evaluates potential changes. Eversource has communicated with the parties to the docket about its withdrawal and will continue to work with the parties following the withdrawal on potential adjustments to the pilot proposal.
