Exhibit 6 - If there is an uplift charge incurred due to a local issue that causes generation to dispatch out of merit, where would the costs associated with that charge appear in the TCAM rate calculation (RNS, LNS, reliability, scheduling and dispatch)? Were there any uplift charges during the period covered by this TCAM filing?

Response:

Costs associated with a generator dispatched out of merit would be included in the TCAM rate calculation in the line item Reliability. In September 2018, a similar type of cost was incurred by PSNH for Special Constrained Resource Net Commitment Period Compensation in the amount of \$15,804. These costs were made to Lost Nation to make the unit whole based on how the unit was dispatched. This amount was included in the September 2018 column of Attachment ELM/DFB-1, Page 4, Line 11.
