Pursuant to the Commission's Secretarial Letter dated March 17, 2020 concerning temporary electronic filing requirements during the pandemic and the Commission's July 15, 2020 approved procedural schedule, attached please find for filing Abenaki Water Company, Inc.'s list of proposed stipulated facts. Omni Mount Washington, LLC, the complainant in this matter, does not join in these facts.
