MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Omni Mount Washington, LLC ("Omni") by and through its attorneys, McLane Middleton, Professional Association, respectfully submits this Motion, pursuant to Puc 202.04, to extend the July 14, 2020 deadline for filing a Stipulation of Contested Facts ("Stipulation") until July 31, 2020.
