

Also, Dennis Moore, Director of IT Enterprise Business Solutions at Eversource will be replaced with Christina Jamharian, Manager of Enterprise Applications Services. Ms. Jamharian will adopt Mr. Moore’s testimony, as well as address any discovery responded to by Mr. Moore in this proceeding.

Both Mr. Rice and Ms. Jamharian have been integral staff to the Eversource/Unitil effort on this docket, and both are witnesses in the joint Eversource/Unitil rebuttal testimony.
