Attached please find the Lebanon Community Power Electric Aggregation Plan for review and approval by the Commission pursuant to RSA 53-E:7, II as amended by Chapter 229:8, NH Laws of 2021 (2021 HB 315) effective as of 10/25/21. This plan was approved by a unanimous vote of the Lebanon City Council on September 15, 2021. The Lebanon City Council is both the governing body and the legislative body for the City of Lebanon.

Although no administrative rules have been adopted regarding implementation of RSA 53-E, copies of this plan are being provided contemporaneously to the Office of the Consumer Advocate, the NH Department of Energy, and Liberty Utilities, which is the only electric distribution utility serving the City of Lebanon, should they wish to comment on the plan.
