Permanent Rate Proceeding – Tariff Pages 6a and 7 Compliance Filing

Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to Commission Order No. 26,884 dated September 12, 2023, attached please find for filing, Bedford Waste Services Corporation's compliance tariffs, in track change and clean, reflecting the rates and terms approved by the Commission. Order No. 26,884 required these tariffs to be filed within fifteen days of the Commission's order. That due date is September 27, 2023. Thereafter, the Commission ordered that the Department of Energy review the tariffs "within 10 days" of Bedford's tariff page compliance filing. Order No. 26,884 at page 15.

Bedford notes that the tariff currently displayed on the Commission's website is the Fourth Revised Page 7 from 2005, not the temporary rate Fifth Revised Page 7. Bedford has numbered the attached Page 7 as the Sixth Revised Page 7 so as to take account of the temporary rate change tariff revision. Bedford raises this so that the tariff administrator will be aware of that numbering when reviewing the attached tariff for compliance with Order No. 26,884.
