Revised Tariff Pages 6a and 7 Compliance Filing

Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to Commission Order No. 26,884 dated September 12, 2023, attached please find for filing, Bedford Waste Services Corporation's revised compliance tariffs, in track change and clean.

As a result of discussions with the Department of Energy (Department) concerning clarity on what is included in the rate depicted on tariff Page 7, the Company agreed to add a note to the rate to indicate that the rate includes both the permanent rate as well as the step increase approved by the Commission. Such a notation has not been required by the Commission in past utility tariffs, however, the Company agrees the clarifying note may assist customers in understanding the scope of the rate.

Regarding Page 6a, the Company also agrees with the Department that the effective date should be the date of the order approving the tariff change, which is September 12, 2023. Thus, the attached Page 6a, now contains an effective date of September 12, 2023 because that tariff change is not retroactive.
