Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to the Commission's temporary electronic filing requirements, and pursuant to Order No. 26,884 dated September 12, 2023, Bedford Waste Services Corp. (Bedford) hereby files its:

- (1) rate case expense documentation of \$46,585.98 (Attachment A);
- (2) temporary-permanent rate recoupment of \$7,101.29 (Attachment B);
- (3) proposed tariff supplement page to recover rate case expenses and also to recover the difference between temporary and permanent rates (Attachment C); and
- (4) motion for protective treatment of certain rate case expense documentation.

With respect to the rate case expense documentation, Bedford is supplying copies of: (1) invoices from Stephen P.
