## I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY AND BACKGROUND

On November 27, 2001, White Rock Water Company Inc.

(Petitioner or Company) filed with the New Hampshire Public Utilities

Commission (Commission) a Petition and supporting documentation for

an increase in annual revenues of \$16,864 or 20.09 percent. By Order

No. 23,874 issued on December 21, 2001 the Commission suspended the

proposed rates and scheduled a Prehearing Conference for January 15,

2002. A duly noticed Prehearing Conference was held on January 15,

2002.

The Commission received no requests for intervention. At the prehearing conference, the Company briefly summarized the reasons for requesting a rate increase while Staff stated it had conducted a preliminary review of the filing and summarized the issues to be investigated in the proceeding. Staff requested permission at the Prehearing Conference to meet with representatives of the Company following the Prehearing Conference to prepare a proposed procedural
