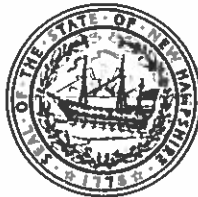

On July 27, 2017, the Commission held a duly noticed prehearing conference in the above-referenced matter.
