

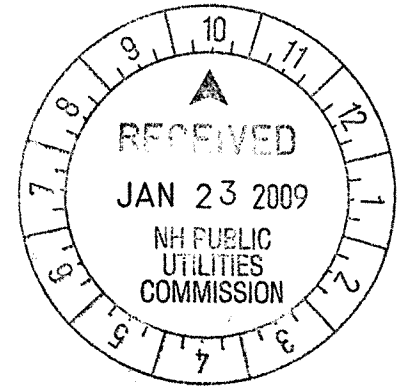

Dear Ms. Howland:

Parties in the above-referenced proceeding have been asked to submit calculations of refunds Verizon owes them for carrier common line ("CCL") charges that were unlawfully billed from April 2004 through March 2008. *See* Secretarial Letter, DT 06-067, Jan. 14, 2009; Letter from Lynn Frabrizio to Debra Howland, DT 06-067, Nov. 5, 2008. Global Crossing submitted confidential data to the Commission on November 6 and December 18, 2008, showing the amounts Verizon billed Global Crossing for unlawful CCL charges during this period. Global Crossing's records indicate that it has paid all of the CCL charges billed by Verizon. Therefore, the total dollar amount for unlawful CCL charges contained in the data Global Crossing submitted is the amount Verizon should refund to Global Crossing, plus interest.
