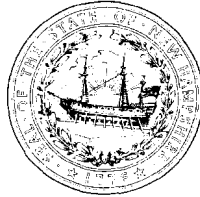

Dear Ms. Howland:

On July 27, 2006, the Commission conducted a prehearing conference in the above docket. Parties and Staff participated in a technical session on August 11, 2006. Please treat this letter as Staff's report of that session.

Participating in the technical session along with Staff were representatives of Verizon New Hampshire (Verizon), BayRing Communications (BayRing), segTEL Inc., One Communications, Otel Telekom, RNK Telecom, and AT&T. Discussion centered on fleshing out the issues raised by the original complaint filed by BayRing. The parties raised certain options for settlement, but reached no agreement.

Participants agreed to the following procedural steps:

- (1) BayRing and Verizon will work together to develop a stipulated agreement on the factual scenario(s) at issue in this docket.
- (2) Parties and Staff will hold a follow-up conference call/technical session on Thursday, September 7, 2006, to agree on further procedural steps.
