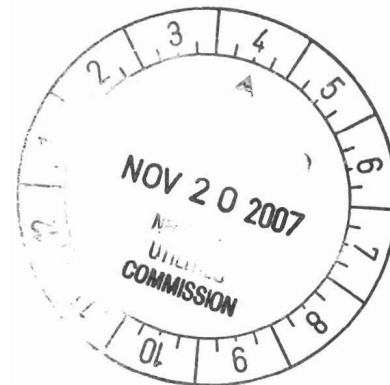

Dear Ms. Howland:

In the 2007 legislative session, the Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard was enacted. 2007 NH Laws 26, Under RSA 362-F:3, Public Service Company of New Hampshire ("PSNH") must obtain and retire certain New Hampshire Renewable Energy Certificates ("NH RECs") beginning with calendar year 2008. Pursuant to this requirement, PSNH has entered into two transactions for the purchase and sale of energy, capacity and NH RECs. Pursuant to RSA 362-F:9, PSNH is submitting these transactions for approval by the Commission.

In support of this request PSNH includes the following documents:


