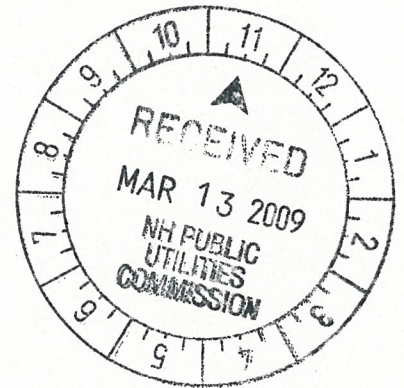

In Order No. 24,889 in Docket No. DE 08-092, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") found merit in the suggestion of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc.
