On July 3, 2009, Sheldon Energy, LLC c/o Invenergy, LLC (“Sheldon”), filed an application with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (“PUC”) for qualification of High Sheldon Wind Energy Center (“Facility”) as a class I renewable energy source under RSA 362-F and Puc 2500 of the State of New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission’s rules. Filed concurrently with its application was a Motion for Confidential Treatment of the Purchase and Sale Agreement for Contract Renewable Energy Credits Between Sheldon and NextEra Energy Power Marketing, LLC.

The purpose of this letter is to notify the Commission that, on June 8, 2009, the Purchase and Sale Agreement for Contract RECs (“Agreement”) between Sheldon and NextEra Energy Power Marketing, LLC (“NextEra”) became effective. The Agreement requires that Sheldon obtain no later than October 6, 2009 an order from the PUC finding that the Facility is qualified as a Class I renewable energy source. Failure to obtain such an order will reduce the amount of renewable energy credits that Sheldon may sell under the Agreement.
