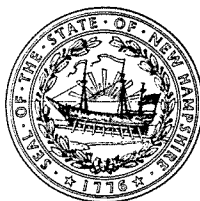

Dear Mr. Epler:

On October 28, 2010, you filed a request to temporarily suspend the date to comply with paragraph 2.9 of the Settlement Agreement on the Time-of-Use Pilot Program in the above referenced proceeding. Paragraph 2.9 states that Unitil Energy Services, Inc. (Unitil) will file a Time-of-Use Pilot Program proposal for its non-residential, non-G1 customers on or before November 1, 2010. In your request, you state that due to the press of business and other matters, you would like the Commission to suspend the November 1, 2010 filing date. You also state that Unitil plans to meet with Commission Staff and the parties to work out a revised filing date. Based upon the foregoing, the Commission has determined that the filing date of November 1, 2010, of paragraph 2.9 of the Settlement Agreement is suspended until further notice.
