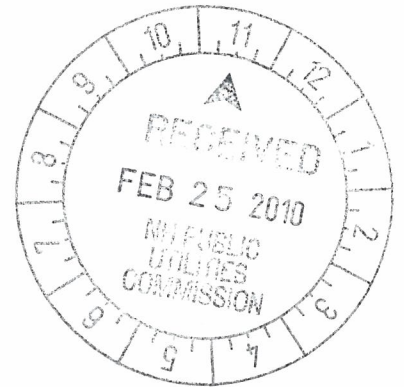

Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission Order No. 25,032, dated October 29, 2009 Docket DG 09-162 ("October Order"), EnergyNorth Natural Gas, Inc. d/b/a National Grid NH herewith files an original and eight copies of its adjusted 2009-10 Winter Cost of Gas rates to be effective March 1, 2010. These adjusted rates require no further Commission action because they are within the minimum and maximum rates set forth in the October Order.

The adjusted cost of gas rates are being filed to reflect an update of the winter period deferred gas cost balance and the projected commodity prices for the remainder of the winter period. The attached estimated cost of gas was calculated using the 15 day average NYMEX settle prices as of February 19, 2010. Accordingly, these adjustments increase the average cost of gas rate by \$0.1075 per therm. Specifically, the Residential Cost of Gas Rate is increased from \$0.9155 per therm to \$1.0230 per therm. Similarly, the Commercial/Industrial Low Winter Use Rate is increased from \$0.9150 per therm to \$1.0225 per therm, and the Commercial/Industrial High Winter Use Rate is increased from \$0.9157 per therm to \$1.0232 per therm.

The calculation indicates that absent the adjustment there would be an estimated under collection of gas costs as of April 30, 2010 of approximately \$2,202,803 or 2.95%.
