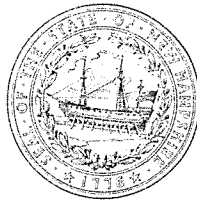

Re: DM 10-003 Technology Resource Solutions, Inc.
Application to Register as Provider of Electric Aggregation Service

Dear Mr. Rowen:

On August 6, 2013, the Commission received your letter in which you stated that you have acquired ownership of Technology Resource Solutions, Inc. (Technology Resource), and that you intend to continue to provide electric aggregation service. Staff reviewed the Commission's records for Technology Resource and found that the registration it was issued, under docket no. DM 10-003, was effective for the 2 year period beginning February 19, 2010 and ending February 19, 2012.


Staff searched the Commissions records for a copy of a letter you provided, dated February 13, 2012, from Judith Messenger of Windstream to the Commission, in which Ms. Messenger stated that Technology Resource intended to continue providing electric aggregation service and that a check for \$135 was enclosed for the renewal fee. The Commission does not have any record that this letter, nor the check for \$135, was ever received.

Based on these facts, Technology Resource's registration has expired as of February 19, 2012. Technology Resource should, therefore, cease any further business activity as a provider of electric aggregation service in New Hampshire.

Technology Resource may re-apply for a registration to provide electric aggregation service. Note, however, that the application would be considered an initial filing and not a renewal. If Technology Resource does intend to re-apply, the application fee for an initial application is \$250.00. Registered providers of electric aggregation

service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000 – Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at: <http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC2000.pdf>.
