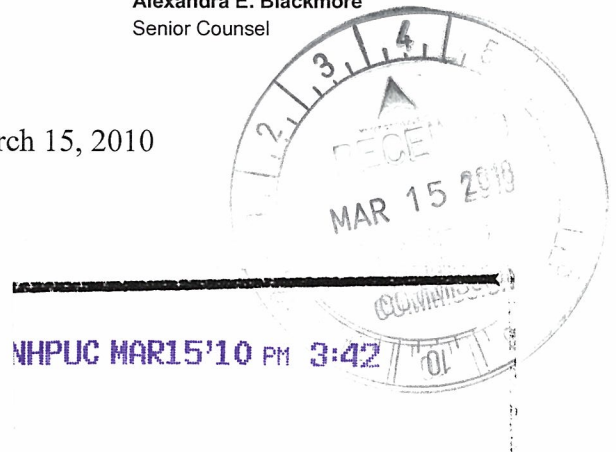

RE: DE 10-020; Granite State Electric Company d/b/a National Grid Proposed Default Service Rates for the Large Customer Group for the period May 1, 2010 through July 31, 2010 and for the Small Customer Group for the period May 1, 2010 through October 31, 2010

Dear Ms. Howland:

I have enclosed seven copies of Granite State Electric Company's d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid" or "Company") proposed Default Service rates for the period May 1, 2010 through July 31, 2010 for the Large Customer Group and May 1, 2010 through October 31, 2010 for the Small Customer Group. This filing includes the testimonies of Margaret M. Janzen and Scott M. McCabe, and accompanying schedules. Confidential sections of certain schedules to Ms. Janzen's testimony have been omitted from the public version of this filing and have been provided to the Commission under separate cover, together with a motion for confidential treatment. Seven copies of the confidential materials have also been provided.

National Grid undertook a Request for Proposals ("RFP") to provide Default Service in accordance with RSA 374-F:3, V(c) and pursuant to the Commission's Order No. 24,577 issued on January 13, 2006 in Docket No. DE 05-126. National Grid circulated the RFP to over twenty-five potential wholesale suppliers, every member of the NEPOOL Markets Committee and posted the RFP on the Company's energy supply website. National Grid employed a procurement process consistent with those previously approved by the Commission on several occasions.¹

National Grid believes the proposed Default Service rates are consistent with RSA 374-F:3, V(c), Commission precedent, and are in the public interest as reflective of "competitive market" prices. See RSA 374-F:3, V(c). Accordingly, the Company respectfully requests that the


