In accordance with New Hampshire RSA §378:18(b), I have enclosed the original and (7) copies of a special contract between FairPoint Communications, Inc. and Bedford Schools for filing with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission. This filing also includes a cost analysis and billing details of the offering. In part to an error on quantities of services the FairPoint sales team renegotiated the contract with the customer. This contract is a replacement for the contract that was approved under DT 10-032.
