Dear Secretary Howland:

On behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("UES"), enclosed please find the final reconciliation of the Company's recovery of storm costs associated with the December 2008 ice storm and February 2010 wind storm. UES was allowed recovery of the costs of these two storms over the eight year period, May 2011 through April 2019. The Company's Storm Recovery Adjustment Factor tariff ("Schedule SRAF"), requires UES to file with the Commission, no later than sixty days after the conclusion of the recovery period, a final reconciliation, with the disposition of any remaining balance subject to Commission review and approval.

As shown in the accompanying attachment, there is an over-collection balance of \$176,229, as of May 31, 2019, for recovery of costs of the December 2008 ice storm and the February 2010 wind storm. However, the SRAF, as a whole, continues to show an under-collection balance of \$2,269,065, indicating the ongoing recovery of storm costs associated with the October 2017 Wind Storm and the March 2018 Winter Storm Quinn. Accordingly, UES proposes to include this remaining over-collection balance in the SRAF. Upon conclusion of recovery of the costs of these storms, UES will file a final reconciliation and propose a method to credit, or collect, any remaining balance.
