Dear Mr. Jordan:

On April 14, 2010, you filed a Notice of Intent to File Rate Schedules (Notice) on behalf of Lakeland Management Company, Inc. (Company) for year ending 12/31/10 which would show an increase in its rate equal to 15.315 cents per cubic foot of water consumed. On June 18, 2010 and again on August 18, 2010 you filed a renewal of the Notice for the company's water and sewer tariff.

Puc 1604.05 provides that a utility shall file a Notice of Intent to File Rate Schedules at least 30 days prior to the actual filing of such rate schedules and that if rate schedules are not received within 60 days of receipt of the Notice of Intent that the notice expires. Accordingly, the April Notice of Intent expired on June 14, 2010.

There being no provision in the Commission's rules for renewal of the Notice, the Commission has closed Docket No. DW 10-106 without prejudice.
