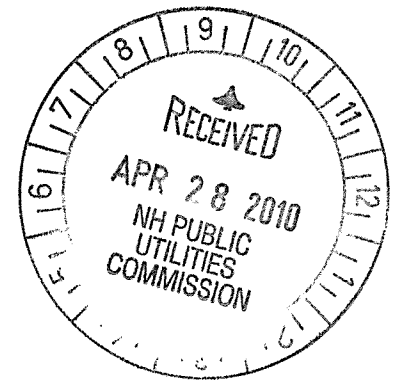

This signed notice of intent, together with an electronic copy on diskette, pursuant to Puc 202, shall be filed with the Executive Director and Secretary of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission). Any omissions and/or deficiencies which need to be corrected will be completed in a timely manner or the Commission may close this proceeding without prejudice.

- Any municipal entity that acts as an aggregator for its citizens shall NOT be required to pay a registration fee.
- There is NO fee to renew an aggregator's registration provided that the renewal notice of intent is made in a timely manner.
- Each aggregator shall re-file with the Commission an up-to-date written notice of intent to provide service as an aggregator every 2 years on or before its original notice anniversary date, which is the date on which the Commission received the applicant's initial notice of intent.
- Unless additional time is required to review the notice of intent and the Commission extends the review period, an aggregator may begin operating within the state 45 days after filing a completed notice of intent with the Commission.

THE UNDERSIGNED, ACTING AS INCORPORATOR(S) OF A CORPORATION UNDER THE NEW HAMPSHIRE BUSINESS CORPORATION ACT, ADOPT(S) THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR SUCH CORPORATION:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Standard Power of America, Inc.

SECOND: The number of shares the corporation is authorized to issue: 300 shares no par, 200 shares shall have voting rights; 100 shares shall not have voting rights. In all other respects the two classes of shares shall have the same rights.


