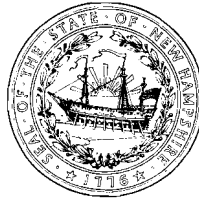

Late Interventions and Modification to Procedural Schedule

To the Parties:

On September 17, 2010 and on September 20, 2010, the Commission received petitions to intervene in the above referenced proceeding from the New Hampshire Housing Finance Authority (NHHFA) and the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (DES), respectively.

The Order of Notice entered in this docket established August 26, 2010 as the date for filing petitions to intervene. No objections to the intervention requests have been filed, however. Therefore, the Commission has determined that no party will be prejudiced by the granting of the NHHFA and DES petitions, which are consistent with the applicable standards for intervention. Accordingly, NHHFA and DES are granted intervenor status. As late intervenors, the NHHFA and DES must accept the procedural posture of this docket at the time of this letter.

On October 7, 2010, Staff filed on behalf of the parties a request to modify the approved procedural schedule. In order to accommodate the volume of discovery, Staff and the parties propose the following modifications:
