On April 20, 2012, Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) filed amended tariff pages for its Residential Energy Efficiency Loan Program. The tariff contained an effective date of May 20, 2012. On May 18, 2012, after meeting with Staff concerning the tariff amendments, PSNH filed an explanation of how the loan program would change to accommodate monies received from a federal grant being administered through the NH Community Development Finance Authority (CDFA). Staff has reviewed the explanation and has no changes to add. The explanation accurately captures the questions Staff had and PSNH's responses. Staff recommends the tariff not be suspended.
