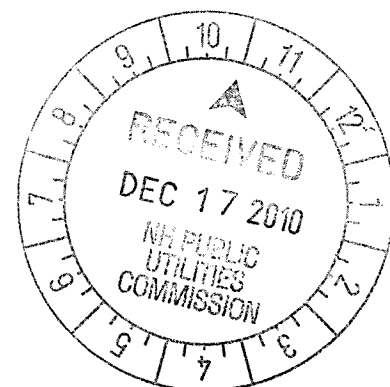

Re: DT 10-211, North American Numbering Plan
Administrator Requesting Approval of a Relief Plan
for the 603 Numbering Plan

Dear Ms. Howland:

By this letter and in an effort to update the record in the above-referenced proceeding, Neustar, Inc., in its role as the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, notifies the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") that the projected exhaust date for the 603 numbering plan area ("NPA") code has been extended to second quarter 2013.

On August 9, 2010, NANPA filed a petition in the above-referenced docket on behalf of the industry ("Industry")¹ requesting that the Commission approve the Industry's recommended relief plan for the 603 NPA. The petition stated that the projected exhaust for the 603 NPA was third quarter 2012. In October 2010, after receiving and analyzing the most recent actual and projected demand for numbering resources submitted to NANPA by the Industry, NANPA released the 2010-2 NRUF and NPA Exhaust Analysis ("2010 NRUF Analysis").² According to the 2010 NRUF Analysis, the 603 projected exhaust date is extended three quarters to second quarter 2013.

¹ The Industry is comprised of telecommunications entities operating in or considering operations within the 603 NPA in New Hampshire.
